Organizes its East edition of NASSCOM Product Conclave in Kolkata

Kolkata, 15th July 2016: The National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM), today organized the East edition of the **NASSCOM Product Conclave (NPC)** in Kolkata at Hyatt Regency. An annual gathering of product and associated services entrepreneurs, VCs, academicians, angel investors, CIOs and analysts, the conclave aimed at evangelizing the local entrepreneurial ecosystem, providing a platform to showcase products and share their ideas with participating delegates.
